## TURTLES TO BE RELEASED

As of 24 February 1993, 1,967 survivors (98.6%) of the 1992 year-class of Kemp's ridley sea turtles, Lepidochelys kempii, were being head started at the National Marine Fisheries Service's (NMFS) Galveston Laboratory, out of 1,994 hatchlings received alive on 14 July 1992. It is estimated that about 1,950 (97.8%) multi-tagged individuals will be in good health and condition for the release tentatively scheduled for 18 May 1993.

~~Hatchlings of the 1992 year-class were "imprinted" to the nesting beach at Rancho Nuevo, Mexico. Consequently, the yearlings do not have to be released offshore of Mustang and North Padre Islands, Texas to reinforce imprinting to these islands as in years prior to 1989. Therefore,~~ the turtles will be released 20 - 25 nm offshore, between San Luis Pass and Freeport, TX. It is possible that additional turtles will be released (e.g., larger Kemp's ridleys held back from prior releases, rehabilitated turtles of various species, etc.). ARCO Oil and Gas Company, Inc. will be asked to supply a vessel for the release.

## PERMITS AND LETTERS OF AUTHORIZATION

The release will proceed under permits issued by the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild

Fauna and Flora (CITES), U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS, Permit No. PRT-676379), NMFS (Permit No. 585) and Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD, Permit SPR-0390-038). In addition, letter(s) of authorization for the transfer of these turtles within the State of Texas will be obtained from the Permitting Office, TPWD, Austin, Texas. Further, all persons actively engaged in the transport and release of these turtles will have copies of all required permits on their person at all times while engaged in these activities.

#### **TAGGING**

Each head started Kemp's ridley of the 1992 year-class in good condition and health at release will have been marked with four different tags: (1) an inconel flipper tag applied to the trailing edge of the right front flipper, (2) an internal, magnetized, coded-wire tag imbedded in the left front flipper, (3) a gouge-type, living-tag on right costal 3 (RC3), and (4) an internal passive integrated transponder (PIT) in the right axillary (armpit) muscle.

#### **ABNORMAL TURTLES AND THOSE IN POOR HEALTH**

Turtles with congenital abnormalities and those suffering from any diagnosed illness or injury will not be released. Determination of health and condition of the turtles will be made

by Dr. Richard Henderson, D.V.M., in consultation with Clark T. Fontaine and Theodore D. Williams, prior to their transfer and release.

#### **SMALL TURTLES**

Controlled feeding (Purina turtle chow at 1% of body weight per day) and projected growth of the 1992 year-class indicate that the average weight per turtle will be near 640 grams by 18 May 1993, the proposed release date. As in past years, no turtle weighing less than 454 grams will be released. It is expected that few, if any, of the surviving turtles of the 1992 year-class will be less than 454 grams on the proposed release date.

Method of Release:

Distance from shore and depth, speed, and direction used for the release will be discussed and coordinated by the Field Party Chief with the Captain of the release vessel prior to the release date. The Field Party Chief will request a release transect heading parallel to the shoreline about 20-25 nm from shore. Individual turtles will be released sporadically along this transect. Releasing turtles in groups will be avoided to spread the risk of loss due to predation over a wider area. LORAN readings will be recorded at the beginning and end of the release

transect, and all pertinent environmental conditions such as sea condition, sea surface temperature and salinity, and wind direction and speed likewise will be recorded.

#### **BEACH MONITORING AFTER RELEASE**

Beach monitoring for strandings of released turtles will be coordinated and carried out by participants in the Sea Turtle Stranding and Salvage Network (STSSN).

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Ground: Government vehicles as needed.

Sea: ARCO-provided vessel (TBA)

#### **CONTINGENCY PLANS**

If unanticipated conditions develop with the ARCO-provided vessel at the time of the release, prior arrangements will have been made by the Field Party Chief with the U. S. Coast Guard to release the turtles from a cutter based at Fort Point, Galveston, TX. Since the release will be made from the Port of Galveston, inclement weather can easily be accommodated by rescheduling the release.

#### **COORDINATION**

Charles Caillouet will coordinate the release with Tim Fontaine's and Ted Williams' assistance. Clark Fontaine will be the NMFS Field Party Chief for the sea turtle release. Necessary contacts will be made by mail and by telephone during March-April, and telephone follow-up will take place in May.

#### **CRUISE REPORT**

A cruise report covering the release will be prepared by C. T. Fontaine, T. D. Williams and C. W. Caillouet, Jr. and distributed within 60 days following the release. It will contain a description of the release, tag code series for each type of tag, a summary of sizes and numbers of turtles released, by species, and details concerning time, location and environmental conditions of the release.
